




Bushels and Percent Change from Previous Year

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






Bushels and Percent Change from Previous Year



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August 2020 Soybeans NASA Terra MODIS Modeled Yield



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




August 2020 Soybean Production United States







Bushels per Acre





Bushels and Percent Change from Previous Month






Percent of Samples Processed in the Lab






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Hard Red Winter Wheat Production United States







Bushels and Percent Change from Previous Month





Bushels per Acre




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August 2020 Durum Wheat Yield



Bushels and Percent Change from Previous Month




