


Each December, NASS procedures allow for revisions to the previous 8 quarters of estimates for hogs and pigs. Since March 20, 2020, NASS has suspended in person data collection due to the pandemic for health and safety reasons. In addition, the pandemic has impacted production practices and slaughter plant operations during this unprecedented time in various magnitudes. The December 2019 quarterly revisions are available only in Quick Stats, whereas all other quarterly revisions are provided in this report and Quick Stats. 












Trade Expectations Compared to NASS Estimates Percent of Previous Year








All Hogs and Pigs First Estimate vs Final Estimate







Breeding Herd Inventory Disposition and Utilization






Feeder Pigs and Slaughter Hogs (1,000 head)
