






#### **USDA** January 1, 2023 Cattle and Calves Inventory



(1,000) Head and Percent Change from Previous Year














### Trade Expectations Compared to NASS Estimates Percent of Previous Year








### All Cattle and Calves First Estimate vs Final Estimate








### All Cow and Heifer Slaughter as a Percent of Total Slaughter








### Cattle Inventory vs Cow and Heifer Slaughter as a Percent of Slaughter










U.S. Feeder Cattle Supply








#### **USDA** January 1, 2023 Sheep and Lambs Inventory




