According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 7, 2019. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 28 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 19 percent short, 71 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 64.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 74.8 degrees Fahrenheit at West Memphis. Highs ranged from 83.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Winslow to 94.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southwest part of the State with an average of 0.86 inch.
