Week Ending: June 14, 2020 Released: June 15, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 14, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 17 percent short, 71 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 13 percent short, 75 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 58.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Calico Rock to 70.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Portland. Highs ranged from 79.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 90.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Dardanelle. Moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the north central part of the State with an average of 3.01 inches.
