# Arkansas Crop Progress and Condition

**Delta Region - Arkansas Field Office**

This report contains the results from the **Crop Progress and Condition** weekly survey and data from the Southern Regional Climate Center. The survey is completed by county extension agents' visual observations and contact with producers in their county. **Week Ending: September 13, 2020**

**Released: September 14, 2020**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, September 13, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 23 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 13 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 15 percent short, 57 percent adequate, and 25 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 62.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Cabot to 72.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett and Pine Bluff. Highs ranged from 79.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 95.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Eudora. Mild precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the south central part of the State with an average of 0.87 inch.
