Week Ending: July 25, 2021

Released: July 26, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, July 25, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 26 percent short, 62 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 26 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 65.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Mammoth Spring to 73.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Pine Bluff. Highs ranged from 81.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 90.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Morrilton. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southwest part of the State with an average of 2.06 inches.
