# Arkansas Crop Progress and Condition

**Delta Region - Arkansas Field Office**

This report contains the results from the **Crop Progress and Condition** weekly survey and data from the Southern Regional Climate Center. The survey is completed by county extension agents' visual observations and contact with producers in their county. **Week Ending: October 3, 2021**

**Released: October 4, 2021**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 4.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, October 3, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 10 percent very short, 38 percent short, 40 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 14 percent very short, 35 percent short, 43 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 58.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Gilbert to 69.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Hot Springs. Highs ranged from 78.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 86.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Nashville. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the northeast part of the State with an average of 2.65 inches.
