This report contains the results from the **Crop Progress and Condition** weekly survey and data from the Southern Regional Climate Center. The survey is completed by county extension agents' visual observations and contact with producers in their county. Thanks to all of the county extension agents who responded to this survey.

Week Ending: October 24, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 24, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 25 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 26 percent short, 62 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 39.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Evening Shade to 55.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Hot Springs. Highs ranged from 67.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 82.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the east central part of the State with an average of 0.15 inch.
