Week Ending: November 7, 2021

Released: November 8, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 7, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 17 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 22 percent short, 61 percent adequate, and 13 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 31.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Mammoth Springs to 40.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Stuttgart. Highs ranged from 49.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 63.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Cabot. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southwest part of the State with an average of 0.94 inch.
