Week Ending: July 17, 2022

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 17, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 65 percent very short, 25 percent short, 9 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 53 percent very short, 36 percent short, 9 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.

Arkansas Subsoil Moisture Map for the Week of July 04 - July 10, 2022

The Soil Moisture Active Passive (SMAP) provides measurements of soil moisture in the root zone as a weekly average, represented by pixels. Each pixel represents 9 by 9 kilometer plot or about 20,000 acres. The SMAP data measures soil moisture in cubic centimeters of water/cubic centimeters of soil.
