According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.9 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 14, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 9 percent very short, 40 percent short, 45 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 13 percent very short, 32 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus.
