Week Ending: August 28, 2022

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 28, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 29 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 33 percent short, 52 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus.
