2023 Arkansas Total Value of Production for Field Crops Up 2 Percent

The value of production for field crops in Arkansas during 2023 totaled \$5.59 billion, up 2 percent from 2022. The top three crop commodities, soybeans, rice, and corn, accounted for 81 percent of the total value of production for field crops. Rice showed the largest percentage increase at 27 percent in value of production from last year. Oats in Arkansas showed the largest decrease from 2022 at 27 percent.

At the national level, the value of production for field crops was down 12 percent, at \$193 billion, from 2022. Corn, at \$73.9 billion, was the leading field crop followed by soybeans at \$52.8 billion and all hay at \$21.3 billion.

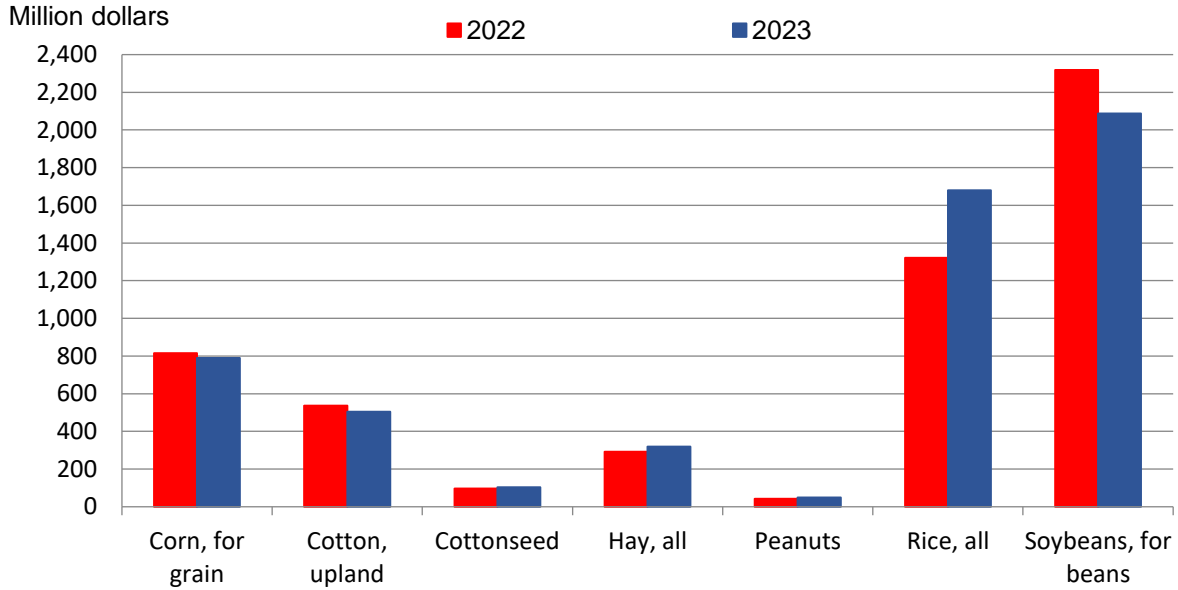

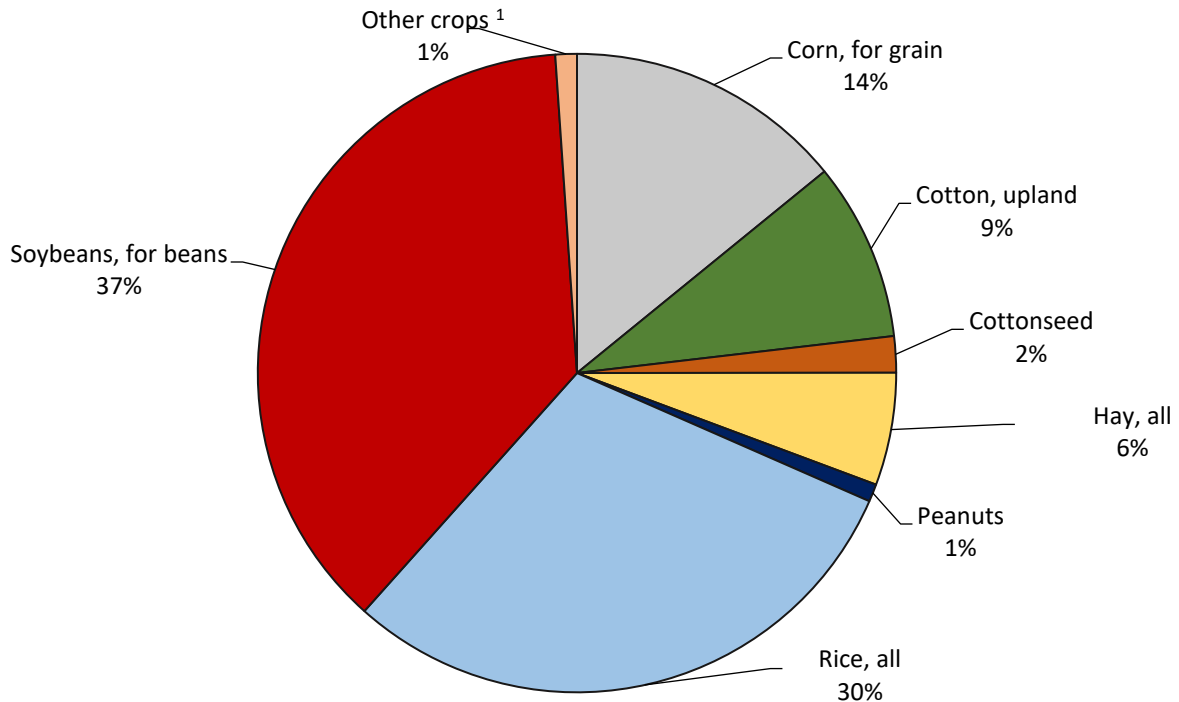
