Arkansas Farm Production Expenditures

Arkansas farm production expenditures totaled \$10.4 billion in 2022, increased 23 percent from \$8.49 billion in 2021. The average expenditures per farm increased from \$202,024 to \$249,284 in 2022. The largest increase in total expenditures, at a 150 percent increase, was for miscellaneous capital expenses, followed by a 72 percent increase for tractors and self-propelled farm machinery, and a 47 percent increase for agricultural chemicals. The largest decreases occurred in rent at 15 percent lower than 2021, interest which decreased 9 percent, and farm improvements and construction which decreased 6 percent from 2021.

Farm production expenditures in the United States are estimated at \$453 billion for 2022, up from \$393 billion in 2021. The 2022 total farm production expenditures are up 15 percent compared with 2021 total farm production expenditures. All 17-line items showed an increase from the previous year.

The four largest expenditures at the United States level total \$220 billion and account for 49 percent of total expenditures in 2022. These include feed at 19 percent, farm services at 11 percent, livestock, poultry, and related expenses at 10 percent, and labor at 9 percent.




