## August Egg Production Up 2 Percent from Last Year

Egg production in Arkansas totaled 339 million eggs during August 2023, up 1 percent from the previous month and up 2 percent from August 2022. The number of layers during August 2023 averaged 15.7 million, up 1 percent from the previous month and up 3 percent from this time last year. Egg production per 100 layers averaged 2,166 eggs, up slightly from the previous month but down slightly from a year ago.

United States egg production totaled 9.38 billion during August 2023, up 2 percent from last year. The average number of layers during August 2023 totaled 384 million, up 3 percent from last year. August egg production per 100 layers was 2,440 eggs, down slightly from August 2022.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Hatched Down 3 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched in Arkansas during August 2023 totaled 86.1 million, down 3 percent from August 2022.
Broiler-type chicks hatched in United States during August 2023 totaled 852 million, down 2 percent from August 2022.
