## Cooperating with the Arkansas Department of Agriculture

## September Egg Production Up 2 Percent from Last Year

Egg production in Arkansas totaled 328 million eggs during September 2023, down 3 percent from the previous month but up 2 percent from September 2022. The number of layers during September 2023 averaged 15.6 million, down 1 percent from the previous month but up 1 percent from this time last year. Egg production per 100 layers averaged 2,111 eggs, down 3 percent from the previous month but up 1 percent from a year ago.

United States egg production totaled 9.16 billion during September 2023, up 3 percent from last year. The average number of layers during September 2023 totaled 387 million, up 3 percent from last year. September egg production per 100 layers was 2,367 eggs, up slightly from September 2022.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Hatched Down 6 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched in Arkansas during September 2023 totaled 81.2 million, down 6 percent from September 2022.

Broiler-type chicks hatched in United States during September 2023 totaled 814 million, down 3 percent from September 2022.
