## Cooperating with the Arkansas Department of Agriculture

## March Egg Production Up 2 Percent from Last Year

Egg production in Arkansas totaled 329 million eggs during March 2024, up 7 percent from the previous month and up 2 percent from March 2023. The number of layers during March 2024 averaged 15.2 million, down slightly from the previous month and down slightly from this time last year. Egg production per 100 layers averaged 2,164 eggs, up 7 percent from the previous month and up 2 percent from a year ago.

United States egg production totaled 9.29 billion during March 2024, up 1 percent from last year. The average number of layers during March 2024 totaled 379 million, down 1 percent from last year. March egg production per 100 layers was 2,455 eggs, up 2 percent from March 2023.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Hatched Up 4 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched in Arkansas during March 2024 totaled 89.1 million, up 4 percent from March 2023.
Broiler-type chicks hatched in United States during March 2024 totaled 854 million, up 1 percent from March 2023.
