Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in California for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 555,000 head on January 1, 2022. The inventory was 1% above last month and unchanged from January 1, 2021. The inventory included 470,000 steers and steer calves, unchanged from the previous year. This group accounted for 85% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 85,000 head, unchanged from 2021. Placements in feedlots during December totaled 67,000 head, 3% above the previous year. Net placements were 62,000 head. Marketings of fed cattle during December totaled 57,000 head, down 7% from December 2020. Other disappearance totaled 5,000 head during December, 25% above 2020.

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 12.0 million head on January 1, 2022. The inventory was 1% above January 1, 2021. The inventory included 7.36 million steers and steer calves, down 1% from the previous year. This group accounted for 61% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 4.68 million head, up 2% from 2021. Placements in feedlots during December totaled 1.96 million head, 6% above 2020. Net placements were 1.91 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during December totaled 1.86 million head, slightly above 2020. Other disappearance totaled 54,000 head during December, 10% below 2020.
