Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in California for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 565,000 head on April 1, 2022. The inventory was 1% above last month and 2% above April 1, 2021. The inventory included 470,000 steers and steer calves, up 1% from the previous year. This group accounted for 83% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 95,000 head, up 6% from 2021. Placements in feedlots during March totaled 69,000 head, 10% above the previous year. Net placements were 63,000 head. Marketings of fed cattle during March totaled 58,000 head, 12% below March 2021. Other disappearance totaled 6,000 head during March, 14% below March 2021.

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 12.1 million head on April 1, 2022. The inventory was 2% above April 1, 2021. The inventory included 7.54 million steers and steer calves, up 2% from the previous year. This group accounted for 62% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 4.57 million head, up 2% from 2021. Placements in feedlots during March totaled 1.99 million head, slightly below 2021. Net placements were 1.94 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during March totaled 2.00 million head, 2% below 2021. Other disappearance totaled 53,000 head during March, 12% below 2021.
