## **Pacific Region Cattle on Feed**

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in California for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 560,000 head on July 1, 2022. The inventory was 2% below last month and 4% above July 1, 2021. The inventory included 465,000 steers and steer calves, up 2% from the previous year. This group accounted for 83% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 95,000 head, up 12% from 2021. Placements in feedlots during June totaled 59,000 head, 3% below the previous year. Net placements were 53,000 head. Marketings of fed cattle during June totaled 63,000 head, 7% above June 2021. Other disappearance totaled 6,000 head during June, 14% below June 2021.

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 11.3 million head on July 1, 2022. The inventory was slightly above July 1, 2021. The inventory included 6.90 million steers and steer calves, down 1% from the previous year. This group accounted for 61% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 4.45 million head, up 3% from 2021. Placements in feedlots during June totaled 1.63 million head, 2% below 2021. Net placements were 1.56 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during June totaled 2.06 million head, 2% above 2021. Other disappearance totaled 69,000 head during June, 21% above 2021.
