Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in California for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 510,000 head on October 1, 2022. The inventory was 2% below last month and 6% below October 1, 2021. The inventory included 435,000 steers and steer calves, down 5% from the previous year. This group accounted for 85% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 75,000 head, down 6% from 2021. Placements in feedlots during September totaled 46,000 head, 27% below the previous year. Net placements were 39,000 head. Marketings of fed cattle during September totaled 49,000 head, 9% above September 2021. Other disappearance totaled 7,000 head during September, 13% below September 2021.

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 11.4 million head on October 1, 2022. The inventory was 1% below October 1, 2021. The inventory included 6.90 million steers and steer calves, down 2% from the previous year. This group accounted for 60% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 4.55 million head, up 1% from 2021. Placements in feedlots during September totaled 2.08 million head, 4% below 2021. Net placements were 2.03 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during September totaled 1.86 million head, 4% above 2021. Other disappearance totaled 53,000 head during September, 9% below 2021.
