HOGS AND PIGS

In 2004, Illinois produced 1.73 billion pounds of pork, fourth in the United States. There were 3,400 hog farms in Illinois in 2004, 200 less than in 2003.

Illinois hog producers had 4.1 million hogs and pigs on hand December 1, 2004, up three percent from a year earlier. The inventory consisted of 420,000 head of breeding stock and 3,680,000 market hogs.

The average value per head for hogs and pigs on hand December 1, 2004 was \$100, up \$35 from a year earlier. The total value of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2004 was \$405 million, up 56 percent from the 2003 value of \$260 million.

Farrowings for the period December 2003 through November 2004 totaled 840 thousand, basically unchanged from a year earlier. The average number of pigs saved per litter was 8.86, unchanged from the previous year.

The December 2003 through November 2004 pig crop was 7.5 million, up one percent from a year earlier. Hog and pig marketings in 2004 totaled 8.8 million head, down 3 percent from 2003.
