




Released January 31, 2022

All cattle and calves as of January 1, 2022 totaled 1 million head, down 5 percent from January 1, 2021. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 420,000 head, are down 2 percent from a year ago. The 2021 calf crop was estimated at 360,000 head, down 4 percent from 2020.
