

## **Illinois Prospective Plantings**

## Released March 31, 2022

**Corn** growers intend to plant 10.7 million acres in 2022, down 3 percent from 2021. **Soybean** planted area is expected to total 11.0 million acres, up 4 percent from the previous year. **Winter wheat** area seeded last fall is estimated at 730,000 acres, up 9 percent from the previous year. Area planted to **oats** is expected to total 60,000 acres, unchanged from 2021. Producers intend to harvest 450,000 acres of **all hay** in 2022, down 10 percent from last year.
