



Illinois Small Grains 2022 Summary

Released September 30, 2022

Winter wheat: Harvested area in 2022 is estimated at 560,000 acres, down 8 percent from the previous year. The winter wheat yield is estimated at a record 79 bushels per acre the same as 2021. Production is estimated at 44.2 million bushels, down 8 percent from the previous year.

Oats: Harvested area in 2022, at 10,000 acres, is down 5,000 acres from the previous year. The oat yield is estimated at 83 bushels, unchanged from 2021. Production is estimated at 830,000 bushels, down 415,000 bushel from the previous year
