KANSAS FARM NUMBERS HIGHER

MANHATTAN, Kan. February 18, 2022 - Kansas's number of farms and ranches increased during 2021, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The number of farms and ranches in the state, at 58,600, was up 300 farms from 2020. Numbers of farms and ranches in Kansas with less than \$100,000 in agricultural sales increased 300 farms from a year earlier while operations with agricultural sales of \$100,000 or more was unchanged.

Land in farms and ranches in Kansas totaled 45.7 million acres, unchanged from 2020. The average size of operation, at 780 acres, was down 4 acres from a year earlier.
