Michigan Trout Production

The value of all trout sold and distributed in Michigan was \$5,341,000 in 2023, according to the USDA, NASS, Great Lakes Region. This is down 11 percent from last year.

Information by sales category was only published for 6 to 12 inches to avoid disclosing data for individual operations.

Losses of trout intended for sale in Michigan were not published to avoid disclosing data for individual operations.

The total value of fish sales received by trout growers in the United States totaled 100 million dollars for 2023, down 5 percent from 2022.
