Corn Planted Acreage Up 24 Percent from 2022 Cotton Planted Acreage Down 28 Percent Rice Planted Acreage Up 18 Percent Soybean Planted Acreage Down Slightly

Mississippi **corn** planted area for all purpose is estimated at 720,000 acres, up 140,000 acres from a year ago and up 20,000 acres from March planting intentions.

Upland cotton planted acres is estimated at 380,000, down 150,000 acres from a year ago and down 20,000 acres from March planting intentions.

All hay expected to be harvested is estimated at 600,000 acres, up 10,000 acres from a year ago but down 20,000 acres from March intentions.

Peanut planted area is estimated at 16,000 acres, up 1,000 acres from a year ago and up 1,000 acres from March planting intentions.

All rice planted area for 2023 is estimated at 100,000 acres, up 15,000 acres from a year ago but unchanged from March planting intentions.

Soybean planted area is estimated at 2.30 million acres, down 10,000 acres from a year ago and down 50,000 acres from March planting intentions.


Winter wheat planted acres is estimated at 120,000 acres, up 20,000 acres from a year ago but unchanged from March estimates. Wheat acres intended to be harvested for grain this year is estimated at 95,000, up 20,000 acres from the 2022 harvest.




Corn: Area Planted - Mississippi and United States: 2003 - 2023




All Rice: Area Planted - Mississippi and United States: 2003 - 2023
