2021 Mississippi Total Value of Production for Field Crops Up 24 Percent

The value of production for field crops in Mississippi during 2021 totaled \$2.86 billion, up 24 percent from 2020. The top three crop commodities, soybeans, cotton, and corn accounted for 87 percent of the total value of production for field crops. Winter Wheat showed the largest increase at 380 percent in value of production from last year, followed by corn at 87 percent. Rice in Mississippi showed the largest percentage decrease from 2020 at 33 percent, followed by peanuts at 12 percent. The value of production for sweet potatoes during 2021 totaled \$104 million, down 15 percent from 2020.

At the national level, the value of production for field crops was up 23 percent, at \$201 billion, from 2020. Corn, at \$82.6 billion, was the leading field crop followed by soybeans at \$57.5 billion and all hay at \$19.3 billion.

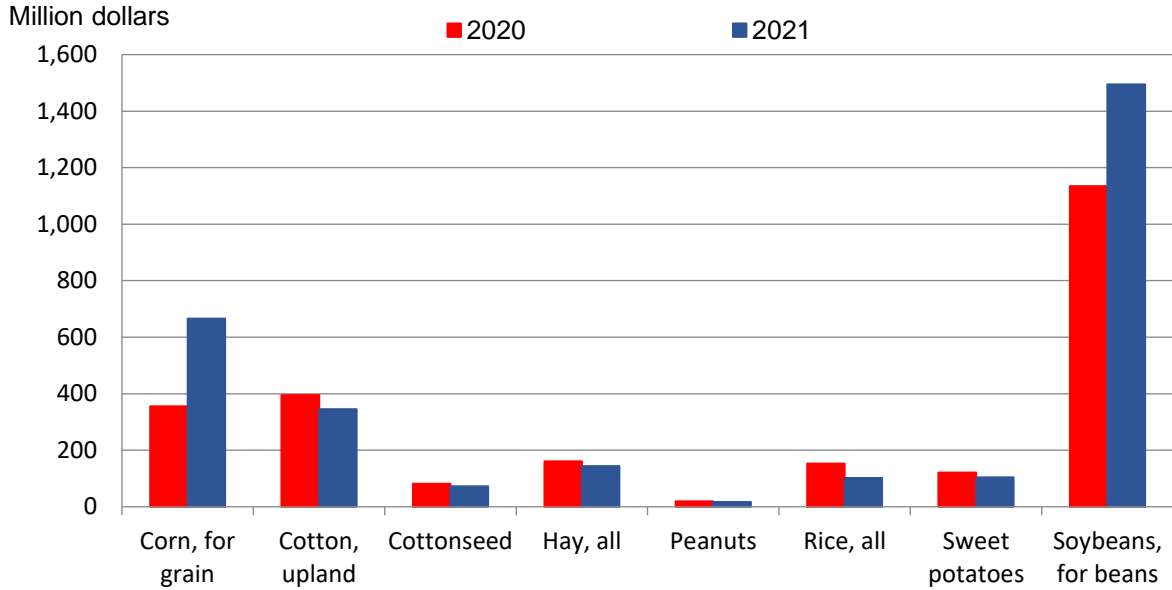
