Corn Acreage Up 21 Percent Cotton Acreage Down 25 Percent Rice Acreage Up 18 Percent Soybean Acreage Up 2 Percent

Mississippi **corn** producers intend to plant 700,000 acres, up 21 percent from the 580,000 acres planted in 2022.

**Upland cotton** acreage intentions are at 400,000 acres, down 25 percent from the 530,000 acres planted last year.

All hay acres expected to be harvested in Mississippi are estimated at 620,000 acres, up 30,000 acres from 2022.

Mississippi **peanut** producers intend to plant 15,000 acres in 2023, unchanged from last year.

**All rice** intended planted acres for 2023 are estimated at 100,000 acres, up 18 percent from the 85,000 acres planted in 2022.

Sovbean producers intend to plant 2.35 million acres in 2023, up 2 percent from last year.

Winter wheat acreage in Mississippi is up 20 percent from last year to an estimated 120,000 acres planted for all purposes in 2023.






#### Corn: Area Planted - Mississippi and United States: 2003 - 2023




## All Hay: Area Harvested - Mississippi and United States: 2003 - 2023




### Soybean: Area Planted - Mississippi and United States: 2003 - 2023
