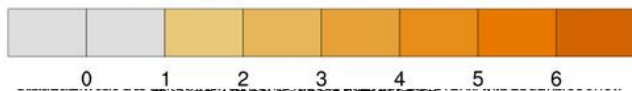
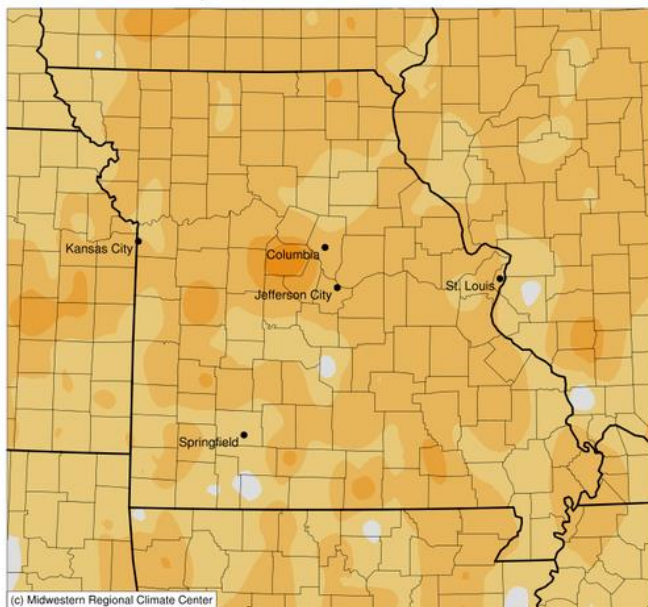


Temperature and Precipitation by Month – Missouri: Average (1991-2020), 2022, and 2023

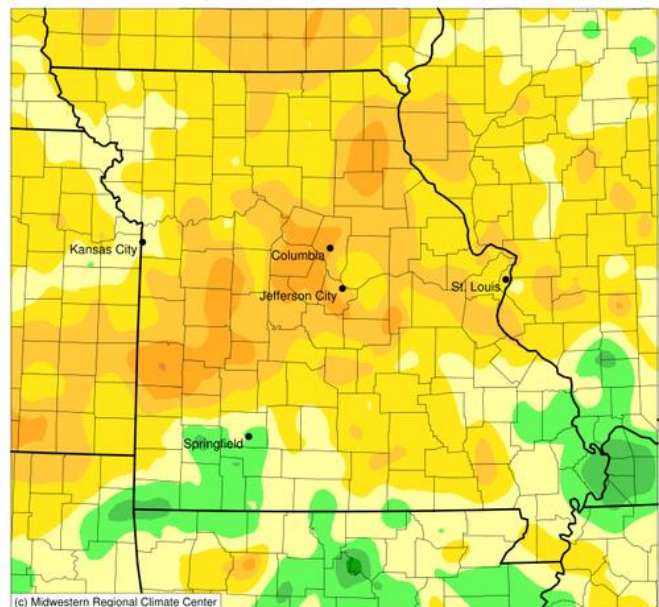

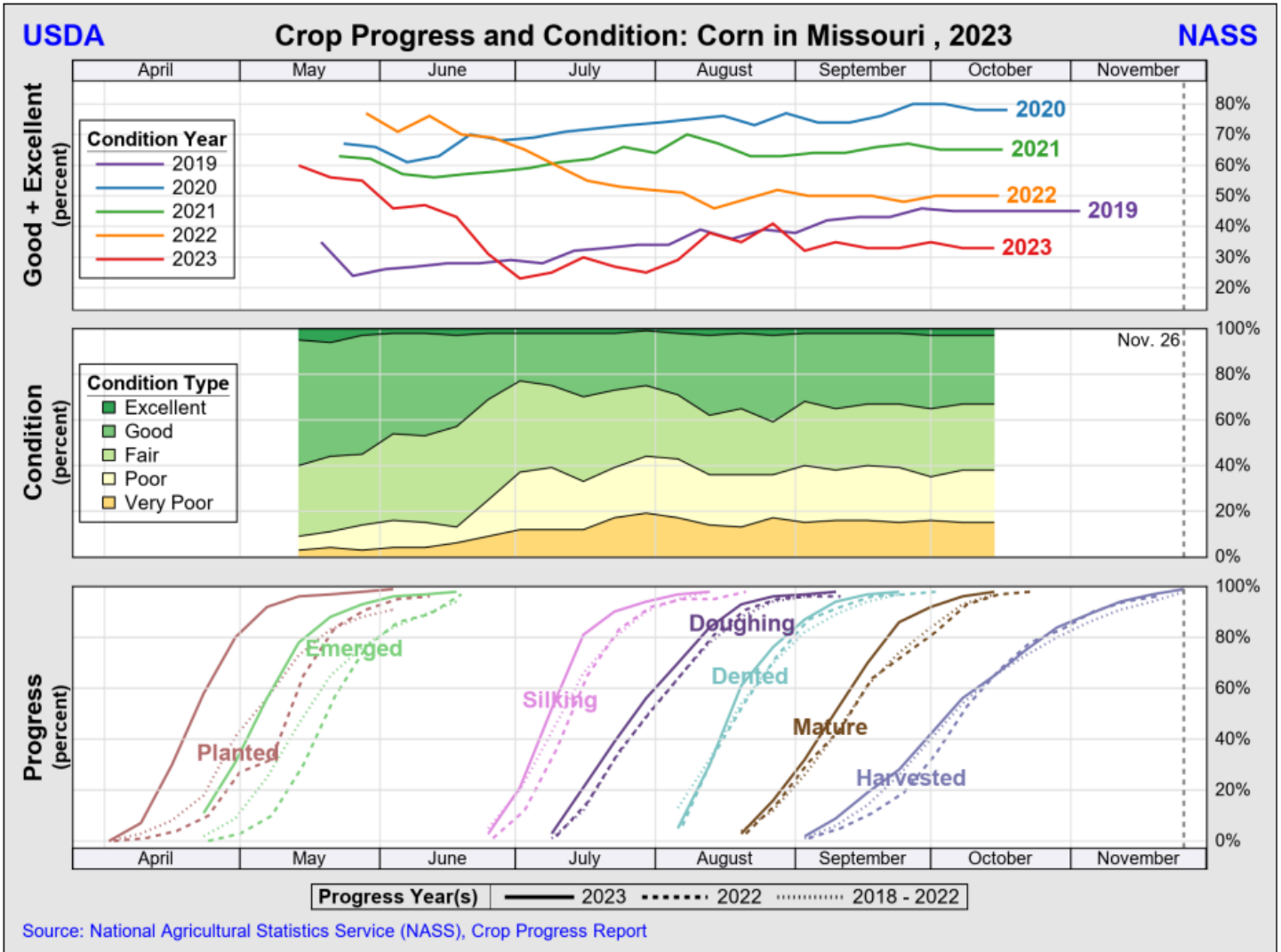


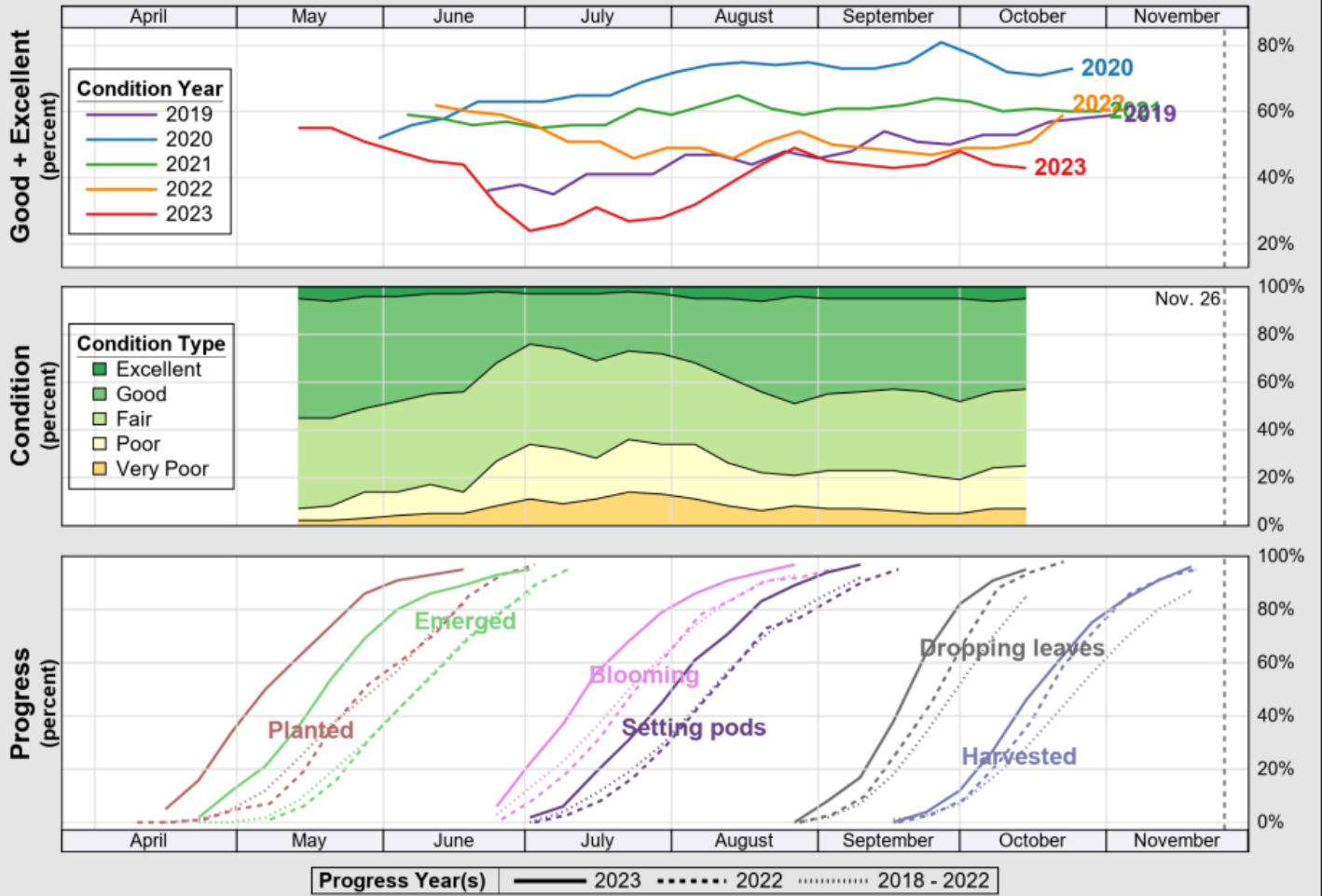
Accumulated Precipitation (in): Departure from 1991-2020 Normals
January 01, 2023 to December 31, 2023



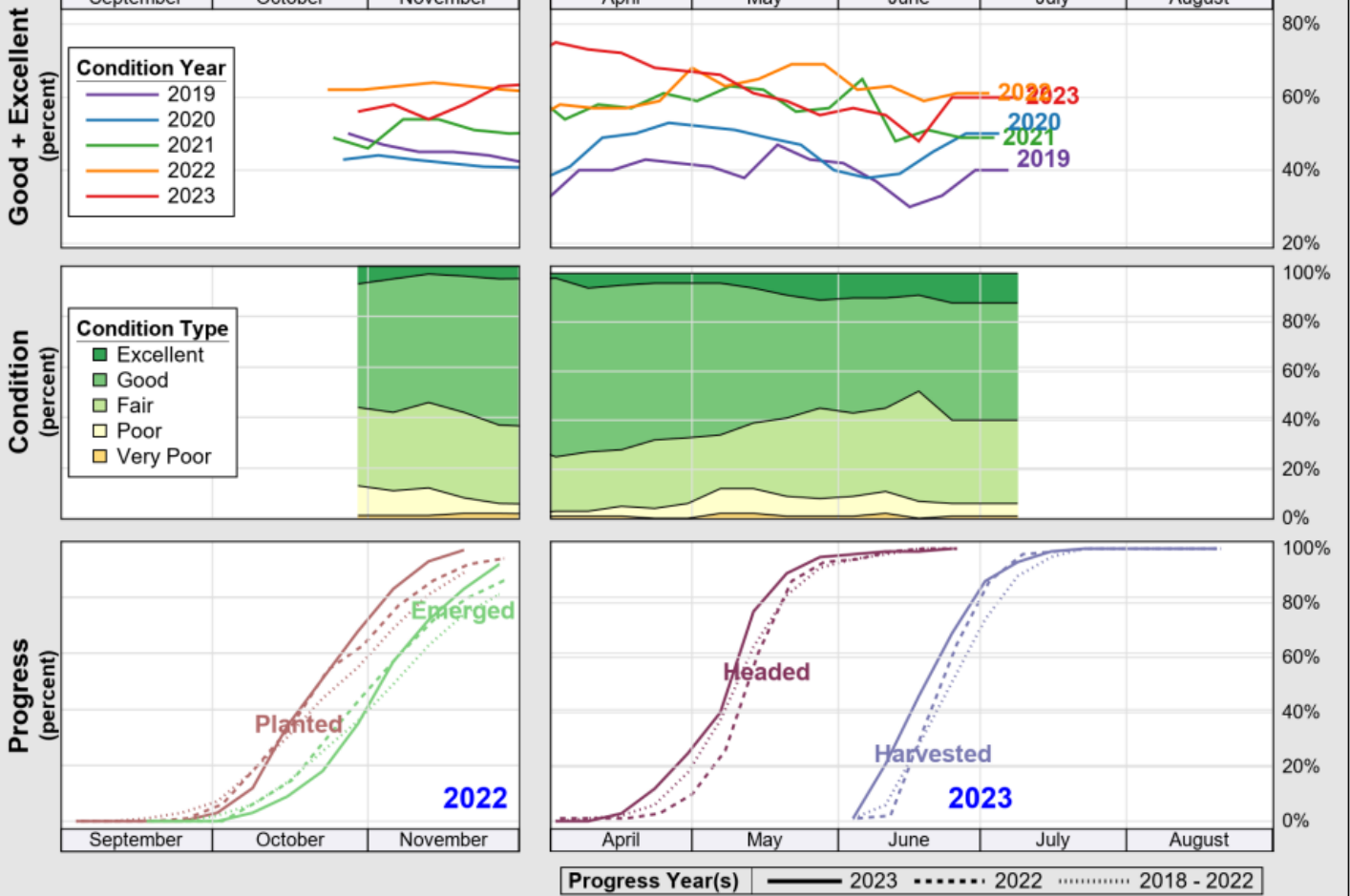

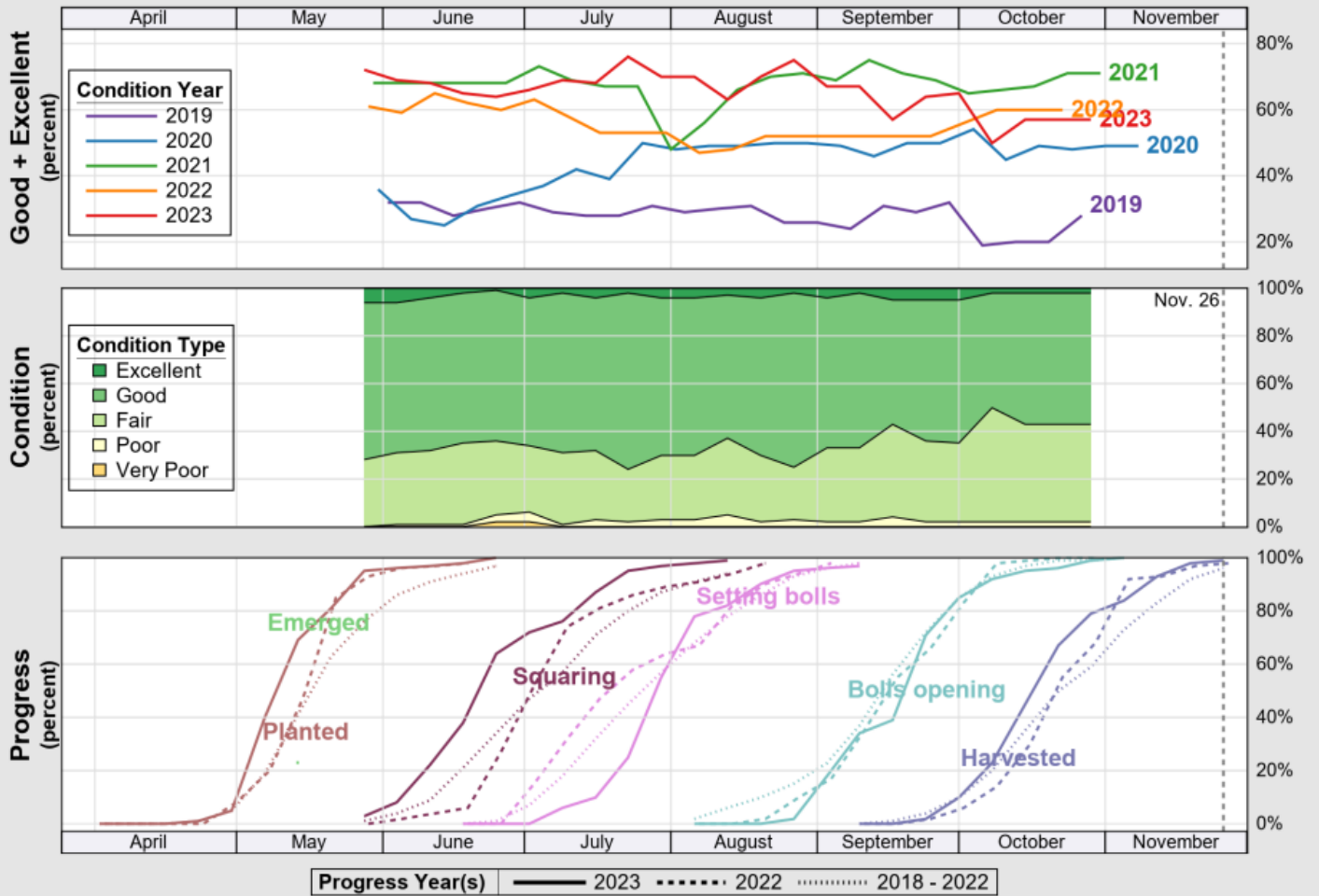

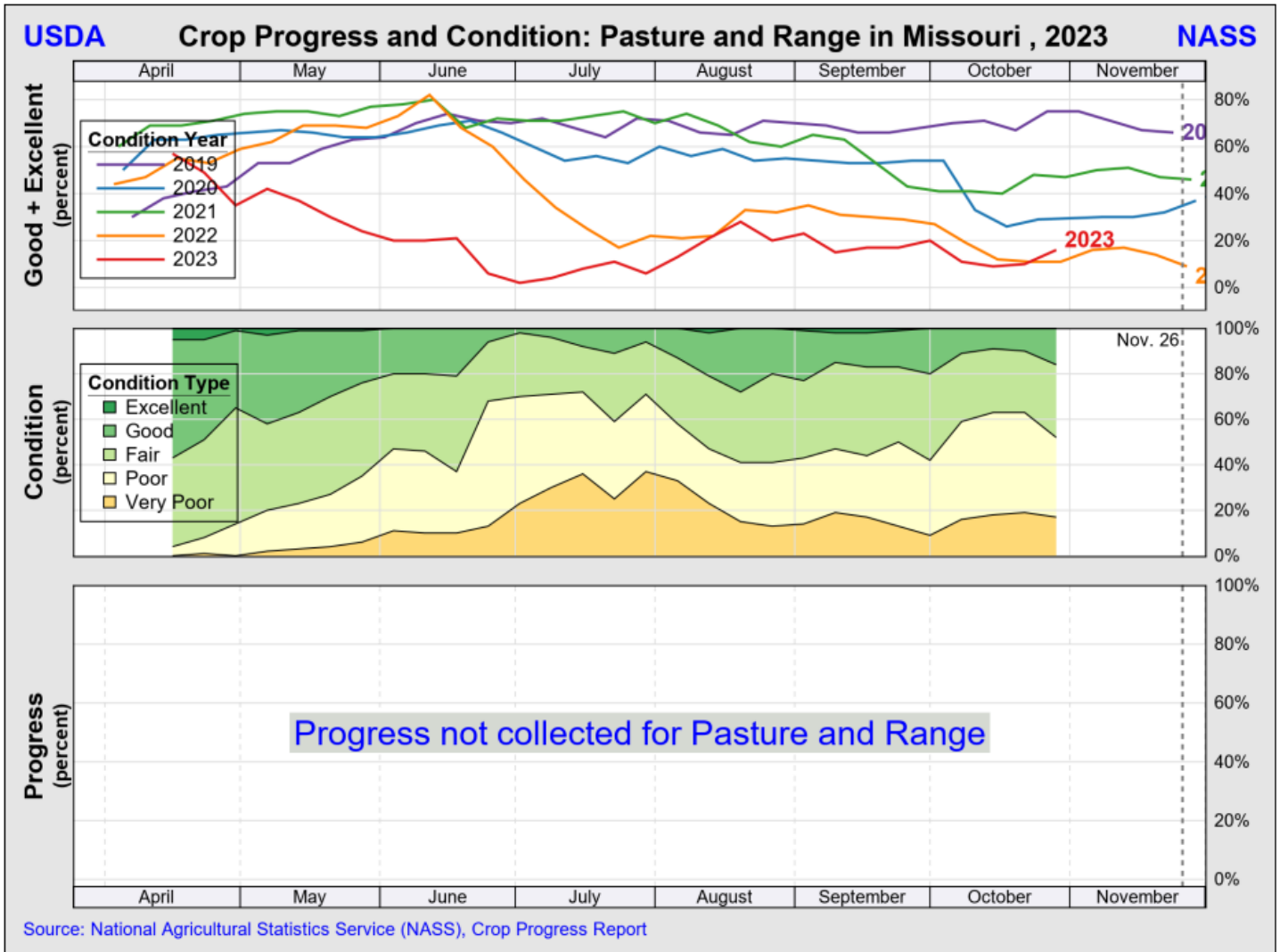
