
All cattle and calves as of January 1, 2022 totaled 4.04 million head, down 6 percent from January 1, 2021. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 2.01 million head, are down 5 percent from a year ago. The 2021 calf crop was estimated at 1.89 million head, down 1 percent from 2020.
