

Missouri Hogs and Pigs

Released March 30, 2022

Missouri inventory of all hogs and pigs on March 1, 2022 was 3.30 million head, down 3 percent from December 1, 2021 and down 3 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 420,000 head, was unchanged from the previous quarter but down 10,000 from last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 2.88 million head, was down 3 percent from last quarter and down 3 percent from last year.

The December-February 2022 pig crop, at 2.30 million head, was down 3 percent from 2021. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 215,000 head, unchanged from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 10.70 for the December-February period, compared with 11.00 last year.
