

Missouri Grain Stocks

Released March 31, 2022

Corn stocks in all positions on March 1, 2022 totaled 204 million bushels, down 25 percent from March 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 120 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 84.0 million bushels. The December 2021 - February 2022 indicated disappearance is 130 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on March 1, 2022 totaled 97.6 million bushels, up 1 percent from March 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 46.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 51.6 million bushels. The December 2021 - February 2022 indicated disappearance is 69.2 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on March 1, 2022 totaled 14.8 million bushels, up 44 percent from March 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 2.30 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 12.5 million bushels. The December 2021 - February 2022 indicated disappearance is 5.64 million bushels.
