



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released June 30, 2022

**Corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2022 totaled 130 million bushels, up 8 percent from June 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 80.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 50.0 million bushels. The March - May 2022 indicated disappearance is 73.9 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2022 totaled 49.1 million bushels, up 20 percent from June 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 22.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 27.1 million bushels. The March - May 2022 indicated disappearance is 48.9 million bushels.

**Old crop all wheat** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2022 totaled 10.7 million bushels, up 24 percent from June 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 0.240 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 10.4 million bushels. The March - May 2022 indicated disappearance is 4.04 million bushels.
