Released July 12, 2022

Winter Wheat: Harvested area in 2022 is forecast at 660,000 acres, up 35 percent from last year. The winter wheat yield is forecast at 63 bushels per acre, down 2 bushels from 2021. Production is forecast at 41.6 million bushels, up 31 percent from the previous year.
