

## **Missouri Grain Stocks**

## Released January 12, 2023

**Corn** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2022 totaled 361 million bushels, up 8 percent from December 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 260 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 101 million bushels. The September - November 2022 indicated disappearance is 175 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2022 totaled 200 million bushels, up 20 percent from December 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 130 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 70.0 million bushels. The September - November 2022 indicated disappearance is 88.8 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2022 totaled 21.7 million bushels, up 6 percent from December 1, 2021. On-farm stocks totaled 6.20 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 15.5 million bushels. The September - November 2022 indicated disappearance is 12.8 million bushels.
