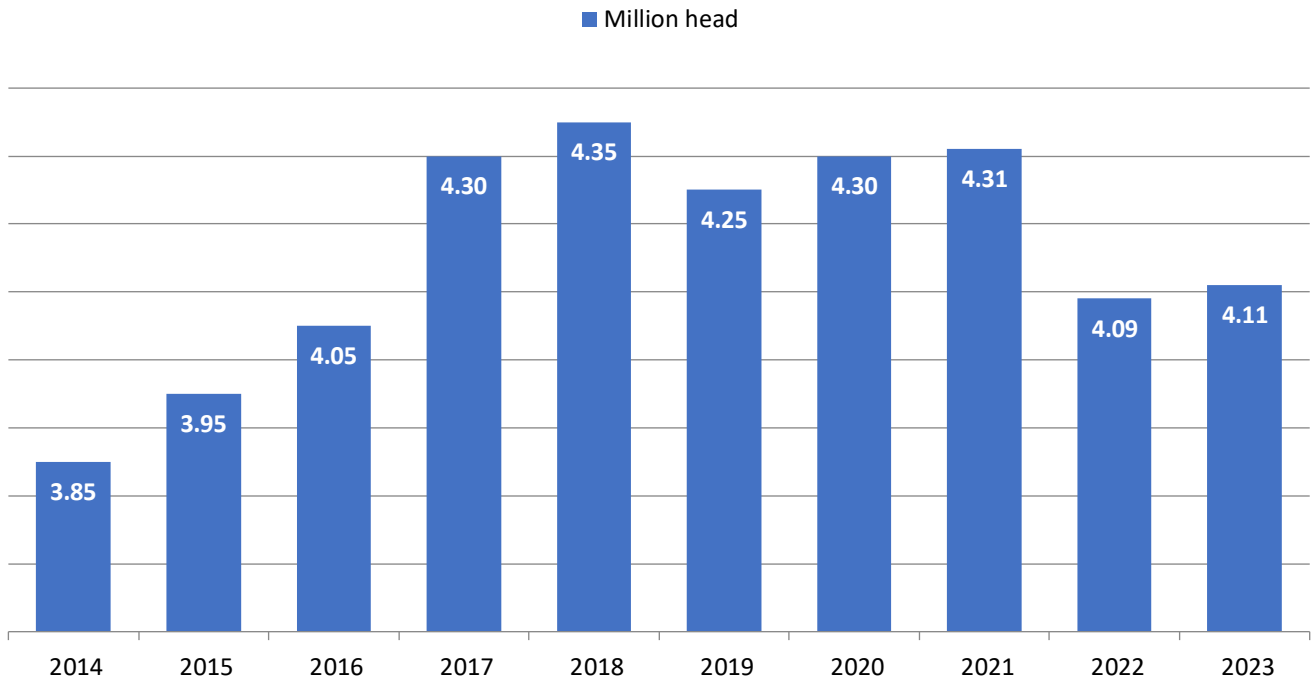
Released January 31, 2023

All cattle and calves as of January 1, 2023 totaled 4.11 million head, up slightly from January 1, 2022. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 2.01 million head, are unchanged from a year ago. The 2022 calf crop was estimated at 1.89 million head, unchanged from 2021.
