

Missouri Sheep and Goats

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Released January 31, 2023

All sheep and lamb inventory on January 1, 2023, at 99,000 head, is up 2 percent from January 1, 2022. Breeding sheep inventory, at 80,000 head, is up 1 percent from last year. Market sheep and lambs on January 1, 2023, totaled 19,000 head, up 6 percent from January 1, 2022. The 2022 lamb crop of 80,000 head was up 1 percent from 2021.

Wool production during 2022 totaled 185,000 pounds, down 3 percent from 2021. Sheep and lambs shorn totaled 33,000 head, up 3 percent from 2021.

Meat and all other goat inventory totaled 76,000 head on January 1, 2023, up 1 percent from the previous year. Milk goat inventory, at 11,200 head, is up 5 percent from January 1, 2022.
