Released May 12, 2023

Winter Wheat: Harvested area in 2023 is forecast at 600,000 acres, up 46 percent from last year. The winter wheat yield is forecast at 60 bushels per acre, unchanged from 2022. Production is forecast at 36.0 million bushels, up 46 percent from the previous year.
