



# Missouri Hogs and Pigs

Released June 29, 2023

**Missouri inventory** of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2023 was 3.15 million head, down 3 percent from March 1, 2023 and down 2 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 435,000 head, was down 15,000 from the previous quarter but up 5,000 from last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 2.72 million head, was down 3 percent from last quarter and down 2 percent from last year.

**The March-May 2023 pig crop**, at 2.44 million head, was up 1 percent from 2022. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 220,000 head, down 5,000 from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 11.10 for the March-May period, compared with 10.70 last year.

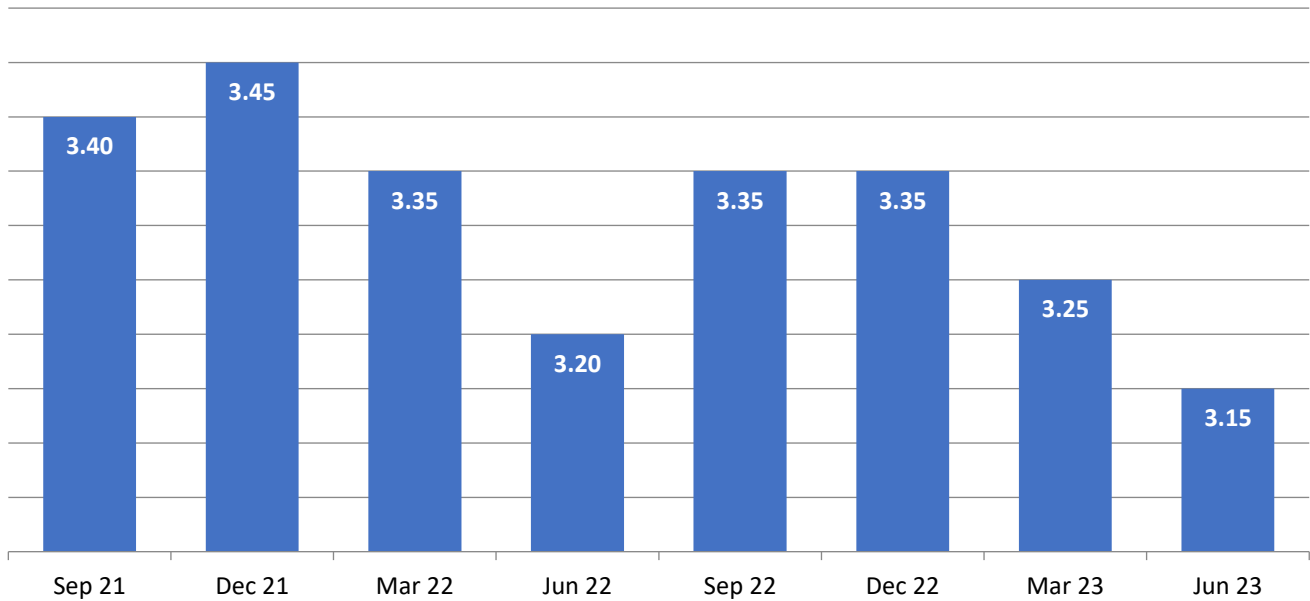
