



Missouri Small Grains 2023 Summary

Released September 29, 2023

Winter wheat: Harvested area in 2023 is estimated at 600,000 acres, up 46 percent from the previous year. The winter wheat yield is estimated at 70 bushels per acre, up 10 bushels from 2022. Production is estimated at 42.0 million bushels, up 71 percent from the previous year.

Oats: Harvested area in 2023, at 9,000 acres, is up 1,000 acres from the previous year. The oat yield is estimated at 68 bushels per acre, up 16 bushels from 2022. Production is estimated at 612,000 bushels, up 196,000 bushels from the previous year.
