



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released January 12, 2024

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2023 totaled 409 million bushels, up 13 percent from December 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 300 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 109 million bushels. The September - November 2023 indicated disappearance is 215 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on December 1, 2023 totaled 176 million bushels, down 12 percent from December 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 110 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 66.2 million bushels. The September - November 2023 indicated disappearance is 110 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2023 totaled 31.8 million bushels, up 46 percent from December 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 7.00 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 24.8 million bushels. The September - November 2023 indicated disappearance is 9.87 million bushels.
