
Montana Certified Organic Production

The 2017 Certified Organic Survey gives us insight into what organic agricultural production is in Montana - from cheese and hay to fruit and cattle. Data provided by organic producers helps expand access to resources for farmers and ranchers to make decisions and to diversify into markets.

Montana's value of Certified Organic sales was \$53.2 million in 2016.

\$39.3 million or 74% of Certified Organic sales came from crops.






Montana ranked # 2 in the U.S. for total Certified Organic acres in 2016.


The most common length of time involved in agricultural production for Montana's Certified Organic farms in 2016.
