CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING APRIL 3, 2016

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: There was limited precipitation across Montana for the week ending April 3, 2016, along with initially warm temperatures. Reporters across the State noted that while winter wheat and pastures were greening, moisture was needed soon to avoid rapid decline in their conditions. Producers in many areas of the State were able to begin spring fieldwork and seeding with 5.1 days suitable for fieldwork compared with 3.3 days the previous year. Producers began seeding barley, oats, and spring wheat with 11 percent of barley, 2 percent of oats, and 3 percent of spring wheat seeded by the week's end. Livestock producers have enjoyed a largely mild birthing season with very few deaths.
