Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were slightly above average for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 88 degrees, and Ely and Eureka had the lowest temperature at 23. Precipitation ranged from none in Tonopah and 0.33 inches in Eureka.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 6 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% Short, 50% Adequate, and 45% Surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 5% Short, 50% Adequate, and 45% Surplus. Pasture and Range Condition: 5% Poor, 25% Fair, 65% Good, and 5% Excellent.
