Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were slightly below average for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 91 degrees, and Ely had the lowest temperature at 17. Precipitation ranged from 0 in Eureka and Tonopah to 0.28 inches in Winnemucca.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 5% Short, 50% Adequate, and 40% Surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 5% Short, 50% Adequate and 40% Surplus. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Poor, 30% Fair, 55% Good, and 5% Excellent.
