Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were below average for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 93 degrees, and Eureka had the lowest temperature at 29. Precipitation ranged from trace in Las Vegas and Reno to 0.96 inches in Eureka.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 5 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% Short, 50% Adequate, and 45% Surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 5% Short, 55% Adequate and 40% Surplus. Pasture and Range Condition: 5% Poor, 25% Fair, 65% Good, and 5% Excellent.
