Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were near normal for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 102 degrees, and Eureka had the lowest temperature at 28. Precipitation ranged from none in Las Vegas and Winnemucca to 0.13 inches in Tonopah.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7 days. Topsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 10% Short, 50% Adequate, and 30% Surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 10% Short, 50% Adequate, and 30% Surplus. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Poor, 35% Fair, 50% Good, and 5% Excellent.
